Pastor Pierre attended Lyce Philippe Guerrier, where he gained a thirst for knowledge and a love for education. As a young man, traveling became a passion of Pastor Pierre as he would travel to the United States frequently in the late 1980s. In search of a better life for himself and his family Pastor Pierre, decided to move to the United States in 1997. Unfortunately, he had to leave his children Dalene, Emmanuela, Nirla, Brenda, Patrick, Garry, and Fredley back in Haiti. In September of 2002, Pastor Pierre met his future wife Alide Jean Louis. 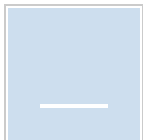
