Alton McIntosh was born on July 3, 1946, to the late Mr. and Mrs. Simmie Sr. and Sadie McIntosh. He and his brother, Elton “Boots” McIntosh were the first set of twins born to this amazing couple. They started a trend because two more sets of twins were born soon after. Alton grew up being affectionately known as Pete. Not sure why, but the name just fit and stuck with him. Alton attended Blanche Ely High School and graduated in 1964. He and his twin brother, Elton, were drafted during their senior year to serve in the Air Force. He served from 1964 – 1968. During his time in the service, he traveled to several states, but spent more time in New York and Ohio. He met his first wife and mother of his children, the late Wiotha Cooper in New York. The late Felicia Lynette was born on September 26, 1967, and the late Alton Christopher was born on March 19, 1969, to this union. After leaving the service, Alton eventually moved his family back to Florida. He worked in the family pool business. Although his marriage to Wiotha didn’t last, he was an amazing father to his children. During their teenage years, he brought them to Pompano Beach and raised them. Most importantly, he sought to build a holy foundation for his kids to follow. When his daughter passed, he was most proud that she was a woman of God and stated that he would miss their nightly prayer time. In the 70’s and 80’s, Alton/Pete joined his oldest brother’s (Simmie Jr.) church, Little Wonder COGIC. It was there that he taught Sunday School, sang in the choir, and became an ordained deacon. During his time there, he met his second wife, Rochelle Daniels and his bonus son, Brock.

That union allowed families to see and spend more time with Alton/Pete. It was a joyous marriage and lasted until the early 2000's. He later returned to his childhood church, Thomas Temple COGIC. He loved the singing of the saints and every now and then, you'd see his hand raise as he gave praise to the Lord. Alton/Pete worked and served until he was no longer physically able to. He loved old western movies, fishing on the pier, sports, and television. Every now and then, you'd hear a belly laugh coming from his room because of something funny that happened during one of his shows. He simply loved to laugh and whenever he was approached, he'd greet you with a "Hey!" and a smile. Some called him a "Gentle Giant" because of his beautiful demeanor. He was sweet, gracious, and kind. Alton/Pete was preceded in death by his son and daughter. 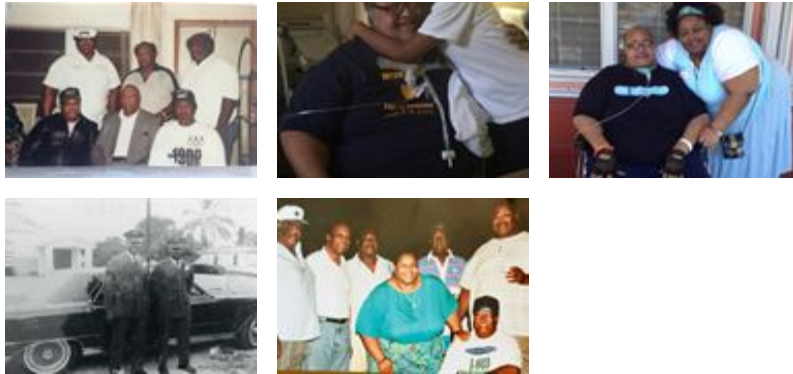

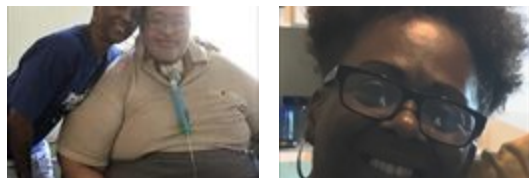
