November 15, 1949 - August 26, 2021

On November 15, 1949, the clouds parted ways & the Heavens released a blessing on Earth, Anelie Jeanty Jean-Jacques.

Anelie was born in Jean-Rabel, Haiti to devoted parents, Mores Jean-Jacques & Camelite Norde. At the tender age of 5 years old, she was well-adopted by her aunt Geneviève Norde. While in her aunt's care in Port-de-Paix, she pursued her primary and secondary education. At the age of 23 years old, she returned to Jean-Rabel where she concluded her formal training as an instructor of Centre Economie Domestique d'Atrel. Upon being equipped with essential life skills, her older brother, Pastor Jeanty Jean-Jacques, recruited her as a trainer in a economic and social development center based in Atrel (Anse Rouge). There she spent more than 10 years alongside her cousin and best friend; Angelic Estime. While working at this development center she kindly shared her expertise, her knowledge and passion to see personal growth in those assigned to her. She was loved by all her students. Till this day, she is still known as "Miss Lali". Miss Lali had a heart of gold for humanity. She loved everyone- even perfect strangers. Her greatest philosophy was "my blessings are assured in my acts of giving". This virtuous woman wore a cloak of prayer and a garment of praise throughout her whole life.

While working in the city of Atrel (Anse-Rouge), she met her now husband,

Daniel Oreus, in the year 1970. Their loyal friendship gracefully became a blissful relationship.

In January 1980, Daniel migrated to the United States of America with an unfulfilled promise to Anelie. On August 31, 1980, Daniel as promised, sent for Anelie from Haiti, where they then settled in South Florida. As the Lord continued to dwell in the midst of their engagement, they joined hands in holy matrimony on February 14, 1981. Consequently, this union of 40 beautiful years never lost its perfect reflection of agape love. Anelie Oreus was a mother to her own children and to the motherless. She cared for her own children and grandchild with the unconditional love of Christ. Mrs. Oreus was a pillar of First Haitian Baptiste Church, a humble servant in the hospitality industry, a homemaker and above all, a woman of Faith. 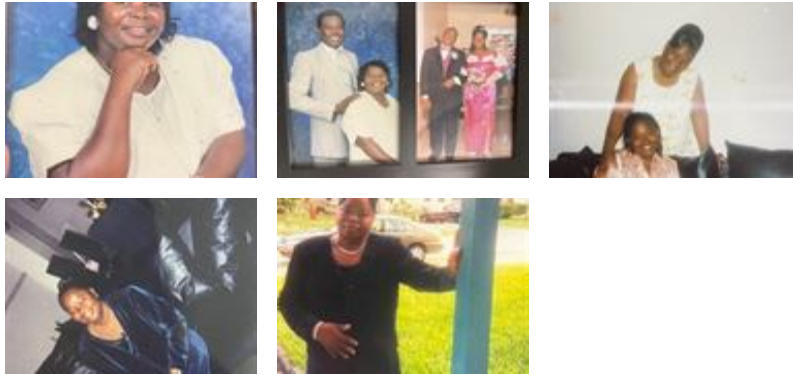

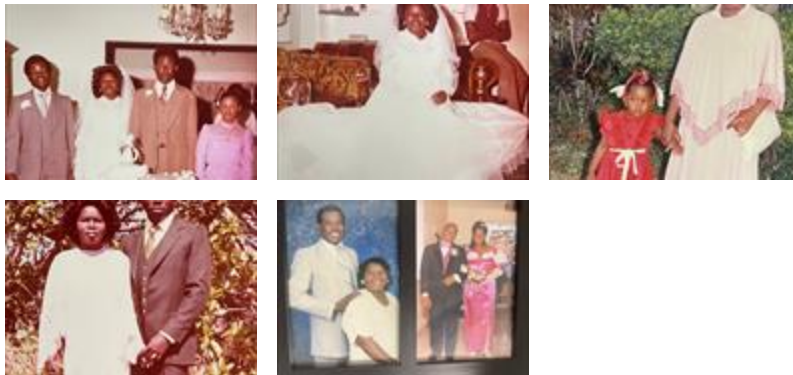

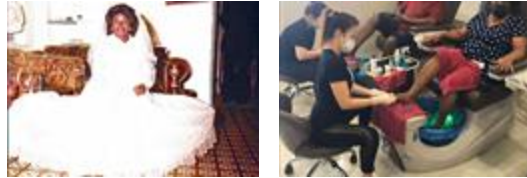
