In Tennessee Beach, she later became one of the leading members of the Episcopal Missionary Baptist Church, working under the leadership of Rev. Dr. J. Miller, followed by Rev. E.M. Williams, and Dr. James C. Scales and the Lord called her home. Sister Williams served in many capacities, including the Hospital Church Choir, Senior Choir (in spite of the church's policy), the Deacons Board, the Mission Department and as an instructor for the Sunday School Adult Women's Class. She was one of the original King/Queen Mother Jamboree members, she also served as a "Church Mother" during her remaining active years.

Sister Williams was first married to the late Lewis Mingo. This union was blessed with one son, Louis Mingo, Jr. She later married James W. Williams who predeceased her in death.

Sister Williams always kept in mind the Lord's charge for provision as well as a Mission. She delivered more than 200 babies, at a cost of \$30 per delivery for those who could pay, while working in the Prostatectomy ward Camp. She later attended the Florence Midwifery School of Nursing in Miami, Florida at night, earning a license to be a Practical Nurse. She worked for many years in the Obstetric Unit of Providence Hospital in St.
