



Betty Buck

October 29, 1945 - August 10, 2024

Minister Betty Buck, a beloved missionary and devoted servant of God, passed away peacefully, leaving behind a legacy of faith, hard work and community service. Born as one of nine children in Dillon, South Carolina and raised in Fairmont, North Carolina, by her loving aunt and uncle, Charlie and Eula Mae Buck, Betty grew up with strong values and a deep sense of purpose.

During her high school years, Betty was known for her athleticism as a basketball player and her grace as a local debutante. In 1966, she moved to Florida with her 9-month-old son, Charles Alexis buck, beginning a new chapter in her life. Betty was a dedicated mother, raising her son and later two daughters, Tasha Jana'e Buck and Nicole Gingeria Rucker (Artis Rucker, Jr.) with unwavering love and support.

From 1970 to 1979 Betty worked tirelessly to provide for her family, taking on various jobs, including licensed beautician, factory worker, maid, housekeeper, and laundry attendant. Her determination and work ethic were evident in every role she took on. In 1979, she transitioned to a career as a nurse's assistant, and by 1985, she became a certified nurse's assistant at John Knox Village, where she dedicated herself to caring for others until her retirement in 2011.

Betty's life took a transformative turn in March 1977 when she received Jesus

as her Lord and Savior. She became an active member of Jesus Supernatural Church of Deliverance, where she worshipped and served from 1977 to 1989. Her dedication to her faith extended beyond the church walls, as she was actively involved in street ministry, spreading the message of hope and salvation to those in need.

In 1991, Betty joined Revival Faith Center, where she deepened her spiritual journey. Her commitment to ministry led her to take various courses, and in 2007, she was ordained as a minister. This significant achievement reflected her devotion to guiding others in their spiritual journey and sharing God's word. One of Betty's most significant contributions to her community was her successful petition to the city of Pompano Beach, Florida, to build a park for the children living in the Cypress Creek area. Her efforts resulted in a safe and welcoming space for local families, a testament to her commitment to improving the lives of those around her.

Minister Betty Buck is survived by her three children: Charles Alexis Buck, Tasha Jana'e Buck, and Nicole Gingeria Rucker; her sister Louise Burley; three grandchildren; PFC Tylor Buck, Tyra Wiggins, and Joshua Bray; her favorite cousin, Buella Wright; Caretaker/Niece/Goddaughter, Jacqueline Marie Flemings; two nieces: Joyce Ann Lacue (Craig Lacue), and Mary Flemings (Sharonda Denise Anderson); two nephews: Tyrone Flemings and Troy Randall III, and a host of family and friends. She was preceded in death by nephew Lynwood Flemings.

Minister Betty Buck will be remembered for her selflessness, unwavering faith, and love for her family and community. She leaves behind a lasting impact on all who knew her and a legacy that will be cherished for generations to come.
