Reverend Richard Broxey, Sr. was born September 6, 1931 to the late Bernice Broxey Williams. He was raised by his grandparents, Abraham and Etta Walker. He attended the public schools of Suwannee County, Live Oak, FL.

Reverend Broxey, Sr. was employed by North Broward Hospital's custodial staff, retiring after 35 years. For a brief time he worked as a Broward County Schools crossing guard. In 1957, he moved to Pompano Beach, FL and became a member of the First Born Church of the Living God under the leadership of Bishop Jack Jones. Later, he moved his membership to Deerfield Beach Church of God under the leadership of Reverend E.M. Parris, where he served as Associate Minister. He remained serving faithfully until he was called to his eternal rest under the leadership of Bishop Patrick Kelly.
