Buster began his career as a Master Plaster working on national commercial construction projects for Don Works and Co for over 50 years. Buster assisted in the construction of Walt Disney World Orlando, The Original Miami Dolphins Stadium, Baltimore Oriole Stadium, Epcot Center and a host of national construction projects. Buster loved his family foremost, but he also had a special love for his local community where he was known as the BBQ MAN aka MR B. He also opened his home 7 days a week to the local neighborhood kids by offering a snack store house where the children could purchase snacks for pennies on the dollar. Buster tirelessly worked 5 days a week from sun up to sun down and on Saturday mornings woke up bright and early to begin cooking BBQ for the community. Buster fed the neighborhood, local law enforcement officers and anyone who wanted a meal. Buster also was the member of a singing quartet that performed at local churches.

Buster's union to Margaret Peterson produced 7 children Margaret Davis (Anthony) Keith Peterson, Geraldine Peterson deceased, Jeffrey Peterson deceased, Ivy Peterson, Patrick Peterson, Shawn Peterson (Melanie). 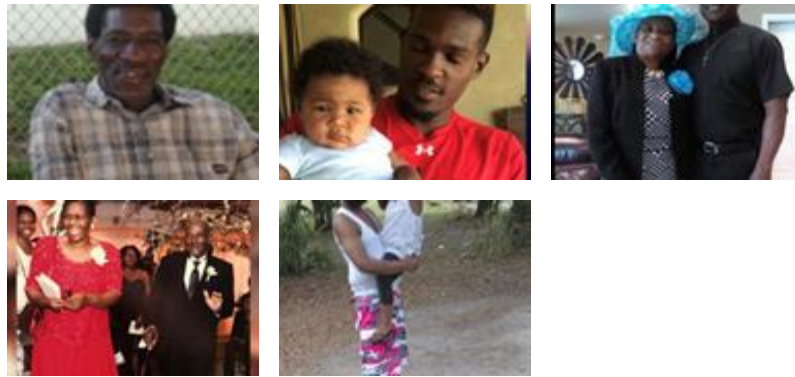

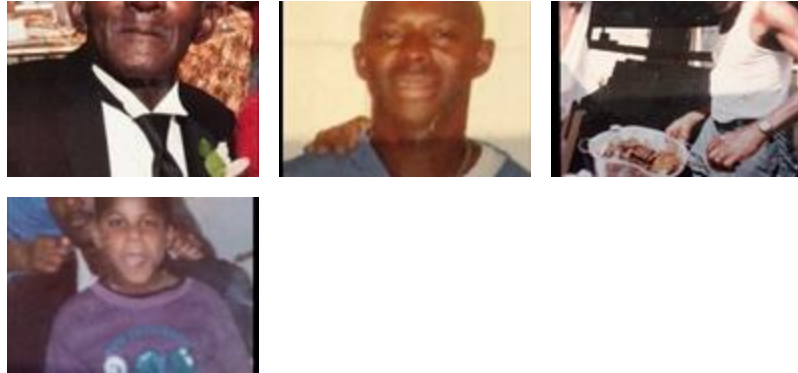

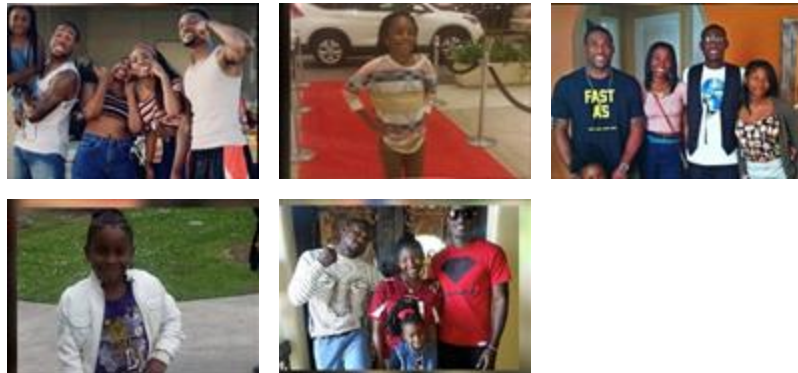
