Cedric Andrew Warner, affectionately known as “Uncle Fat-Fat,” passed away, leaving a legacy of laughter, loyalty, and love. 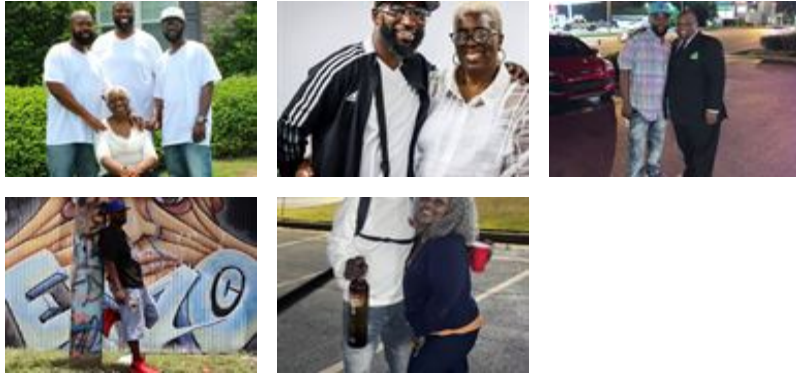
