Claude Lee Baker was born into this world on May 13th
to his beloved parents:

As a child, Claude grew up in the beautiful city of Pompano Beach, Florida, where he attended Greater Bethel AME Church in Pompano Beach, Fl. In his later years of life he attended Mt. Olive Baptist Church in Ft. Lauderdale, Fl. Claude received his education at Coleman Elementary School and then Ely High School. His classmates described him as a “smart businessman who loved making money.”

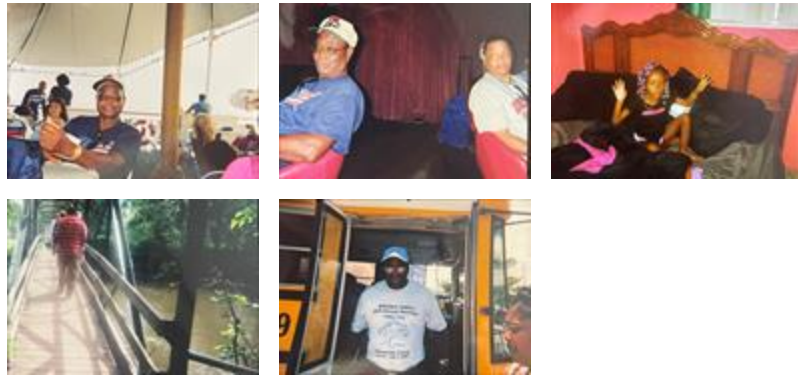

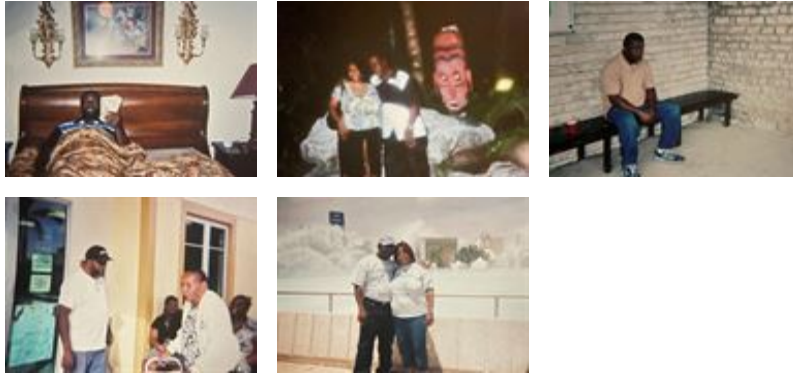

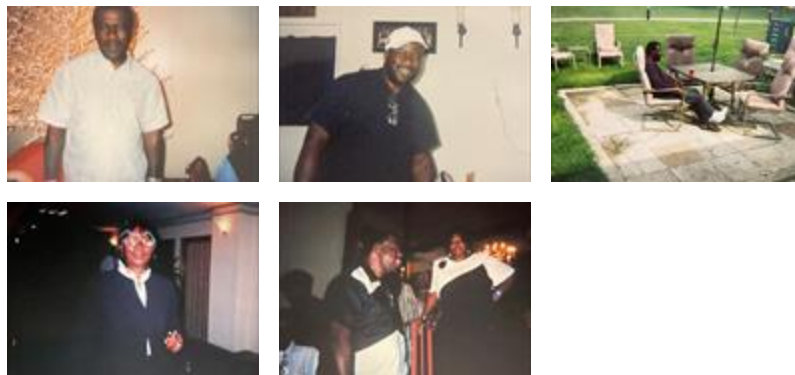
