Daisy Mae Allen was born on August 14, 1943 in Vidalia, Georgia to the late Frank Wilcher and Sarah Wilcher. She was the second of five siblings born to this union, three of which preceded her in death: Juanita, John Willie and Teresa.

She received her formal education in the Broward County Public Schools and further studied at Broward College in Davie, Florida. She was united in Holy Matrimony to Jethro Allen, Jr. on June 24, 1972.

She accepted Christ as her personal Savior at an early age and later became a member of First Baptist Church of Collier City where she worked faithfully until her health began to decline. She was a Deaconess, Missionary, Sunday School Teacher, and past president of the First Macedonia Baptist Association for approximately 10 years.

Daisy's work experiences included employment in Food Services at Broward County Schools and several local hospitals which led her in becoming supervisor of Catering Services for the First Baptist Church of Pompano Beach. She performed her responsibilities with high standards and

professionalism. She retired in 1985.

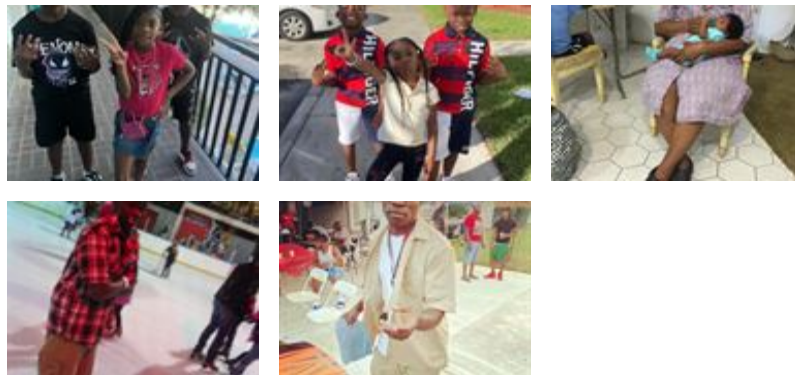

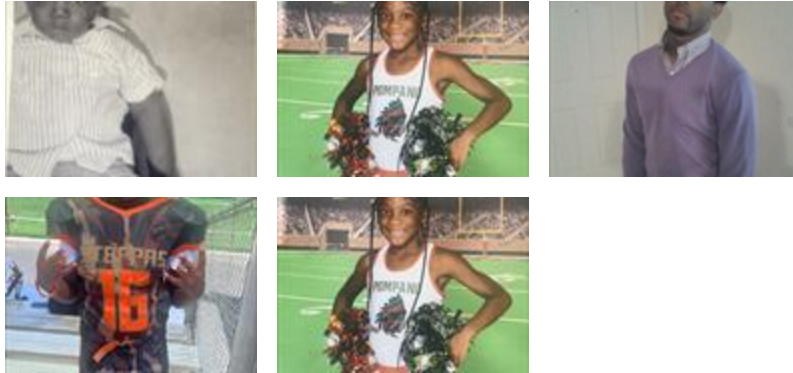

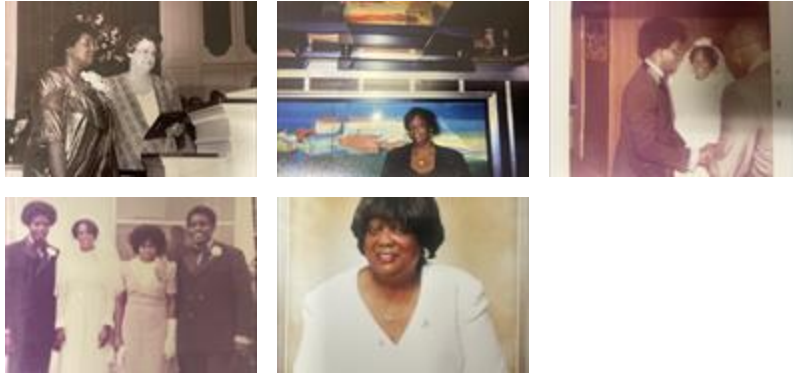
