After much suffering, he was granted his wish to spend his last days at home surrounded by his closest family and the ones dearest to his heart. On August 26th, 2020 at the age 71 he ultimately took his last breath and went on to rest in the care of his Heavenly Father.

Dieunoussa also known as "Dennis" was born August 28th, 1949 in La-tortue, Haiti where he spent his days as a young boy. In 1963 he moved over to Nassau, Bahamas. He spent most of his youth there in the Bahamas. As a young adult, he migrated to the United States in 1977 and made Fort Lauderdale, Florida his permanent residence.

Shortly after his arrival to Florida, he met his first wife Carmelite Etienne whom he married in 1986. From that marriage, he was blessed with his two beautiful daughters, his first born Evelyn Ceremy and Vivian Ceremy the

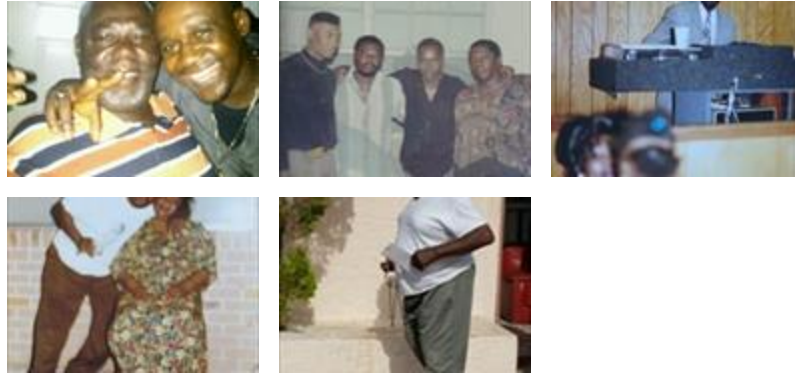

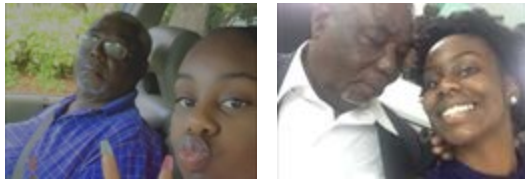

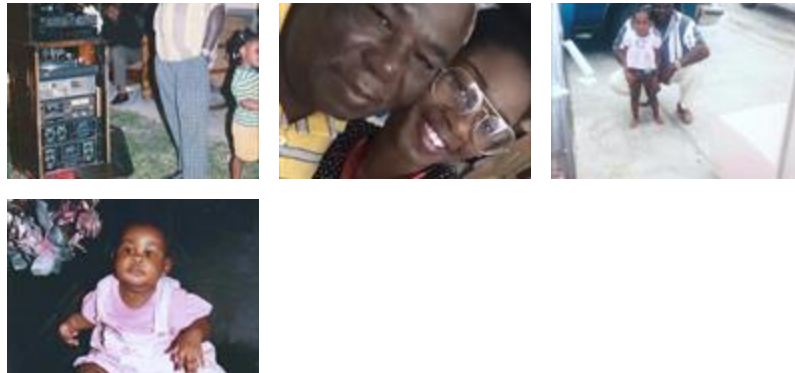
