Emma Branch was born on November 14, 1941, in Hahira, Georgia to the parentage of the late Clarence Walker and Bertha M. Ealy Walker. Preceded her in death were both parents and her beloved sister Helen E. Walker Crouch. In 1956, Emma moved to Florida, attended Blanche Ely High School (Class of 1960) and received her diploma.

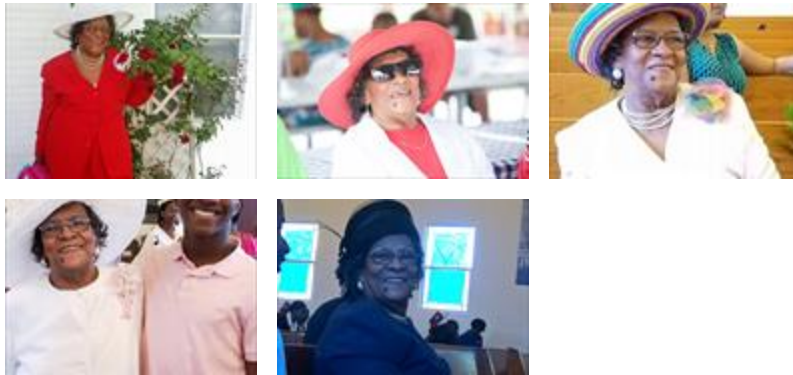
