church with Pastor Fannie Martin at the passing of her husband and Senior Pastor Elder Samuel Martin. It was during his return service to Kings Temple Revival Center that Elder Eugene Cooper received the higher call from the Father to search out and lead a new following as Ordained Pastor. Eagles Life Ministry Church of the Living God was founded in the year of our Lord 1998 By then Elder (Ordained by Bishop Felton Snell as Pastor) and his wife Then Prophetess Earnestine Cooper. Bishop was ordained as Bishop and Overseer in December of 2003. Bishop loved his church family and all who were acquainted with him. He was a brutally honest person who believed in speaking his mind and the truth. If you don't want to hear the truth you don't ask Bishop. He loved his wife and children without bias and there was no secret to those who knew him all knew of his favor! Preceded him in death, Son Rodney A Davis and Brother Ethridge Phillips Jr. Bishop Eugene "Bilbo" Cooper was survived by his family. 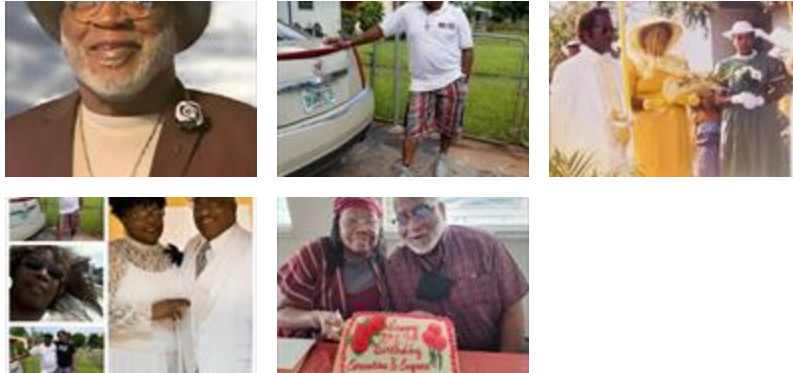
