She spent most of her childhood and early adult years in Anse-Rouge until 1965 she met the love of her life, Dominique Alexandre. The two began their lives together and very soon after that they had their first child. However, few years later Dominique passed away in 1973, leaving France as the sole provider for the children. In 1979, as a widow she moved to the United States in search of better life and to provide better means for her family. In the US, she settled in Pompano Beach, Florida, where she worked for various employers while doing business in Haiti until she was able to relocate her children to live with her. Later France suffered a horrible stroke which left her paralyzed and speechless for over 20 years until her

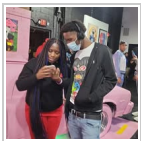
