A Time To Serve: Frances Davis became a devoted member of Mount Zion Missionary Baptist Church and served faithfully for over 60 years. She was a member of the Senior and Mass Choirs and also a director of the Junior Choir for several years. Frances Davis was one of the founders of Mount Zion Pastor's Aide. She was later appointed Church Mother. After her health began to fail she stop singing in the choirs but continued to attend as regularly as she could. However, she continued to sing a few of her old Zion songs at home and never stop praying. Frances Davis and the late Sister Louise Dixon were founders of the Miracle Faith Prayer Band. This outreach ministry touched many lives in the community.

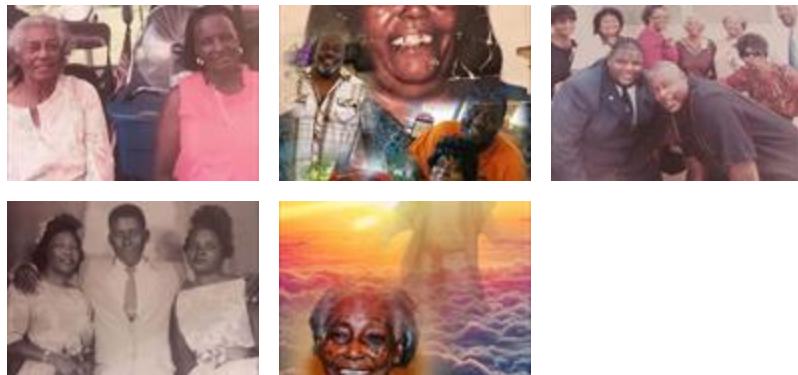
