George LeMorris Jones was born to the late Jimmie and Louise Jones on February 22, 1954, in Fort Lauderdale, FL. 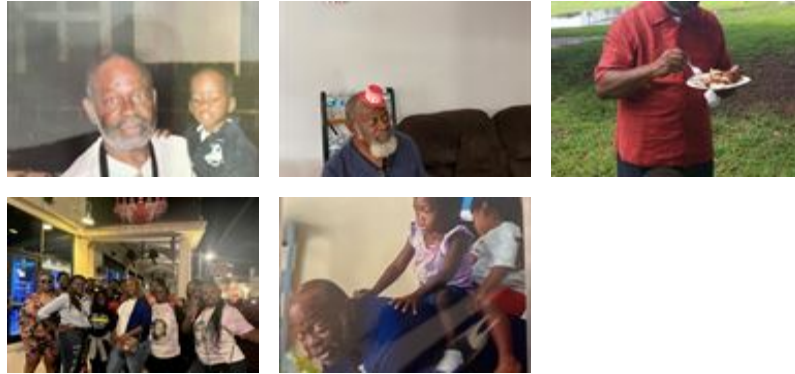
