Mr. Gilbert Alexandre was born on February 9, 1944, in Port-de Paix (Gola), Haiti. He was a devout Catholic and a true man of God. Mr. Alexandre was a practical joker with a generous heart of gold. A hard worker and resilient in figure in the face of adversity who never hesitated to help people out. Mr. Gilbert migrated to Nassau, Bahamas at the age of seventeen. There he worked odd jobs before finding his passion in construction. Mr. Gilbert, also known as Mr. Al, was preceded in death by his father, Guilbert Alexandre; mother, Goasena Alexandre and brother Vilbrium Alexandre.

On May 6, 2022, Gilbert passed away at the age of 78, due to metastatic cancer from an unspecified origin. Just like Mr. Al dealt with all experiences in life, he managed his illness with strength. He peacefully set sail in the arms of his wife Magalie Fenelus-Alexandre, 54 years of marriage. 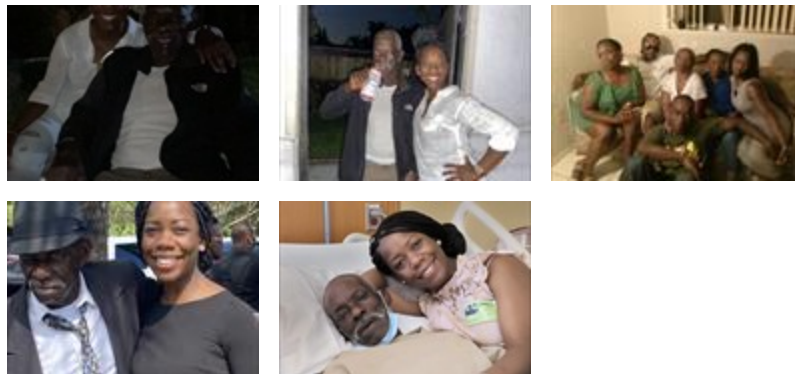
