Henry “Duke” Herbert, 86 of Stuart, Florida departed this life on Monday, September 28, 2020 at the Leesburg Regional Medical Center in Leesburg, Florida.

Henry was born on March 10, 1934 in Moorehaven (Benbow Camp), Florida to Neta Everett Herbert-Hallback (deceased) and Cleve Herbert (deceased). He grew up in a loving family with 1 brother and 4 sisters. Henry joined the Army where he proudly served his country during the Korean War until he was Honorably Discharged in 1956.
