Even in his last battle we just kept waiting for him to prove the doctors wrong again and defy the odds for us ones more. But he was tired and he couldn't be our superman anymore.

Jean Claude enjoyed reading the Bible and was studying the bible with Jehovah's witnesses on regularly basis before the Pandemic. Even in the final days of his life he was asking question about the Bible and wishing he had done more to please God during his youth.

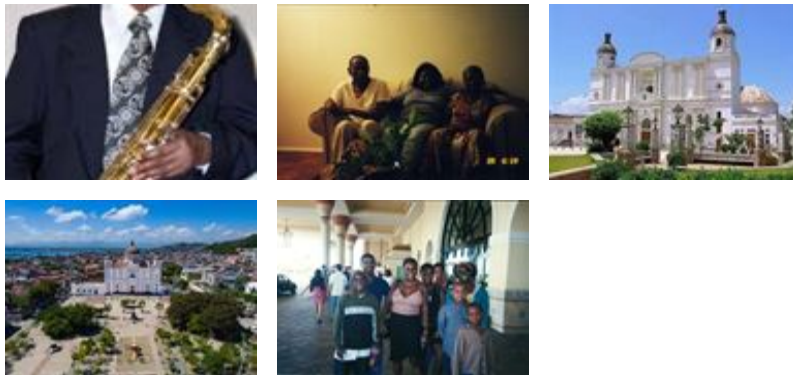
