Johnnie Coy McElhaney, affectionately known as “Johnnie Mac” by family and friends, quietly answered the call to be with the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, at 6:23 a.m., Monday, July 15th, 2019.

Born in Wray, Georgia on December 19, 1943, Johnnie was the eldest of nine (9) children of Pink C. and Oscie E. McElhaney. He attended school in Irwin County, GA, and worked there as a farmer until 1972. After relocating to Pompano Beach, Florida, Mr. Johnnie worked for Shaw Construction Company, and shortly thereafter, was hired by and made his way through the ranks of the City of Pompano Beach. By exhibiting leadership qualities, he became a Foreman of Sewer Transmission Department. He retired after 39 years of dedicated service and hard labor.

On January 14, 2005, Johnnie McElhaney and Clerethe Stanley (affectionately known as “Key”), were joined in holy matrimony at the Word of the Living God Ministry in Pompano Beach. They had a happy, successful and faithful 15 year marriage.

Johnnie Mac was a devoted and active member of Rightway Ministries, under the leadership of Bishop Marcus Neloms, located in Fort Lauderdale, Florida,

for over 30 years. He served on the "Total Men Ministry." He was also well known in Pompano and famous for delicious barbeque "ribs and rib tips". Johnnie was preceded in death by one brother, Jimmie C. McElhaney and one sister, Dora McElhaney.
