Johnny George Mapp Sr. was born on June 30, 1935 in Salisbury, Maryland to the parents of Moses and Anna Bell Mapp, both of whom preceded him in death. He was educated in the Salisbury, Maryland School System. During his High School years, he was an aspiring basketball player where he led his team to numerous championship titles and was also voted MVP during those championship runs. As a young man, pursuing job opportunities, he moved to South Florida and worked as a chef at a Beach Resort on Pompano Beach. Later in life he also worked for two communications firms in Fort Lauderdale and Boca Raton. While also owning and operating a commercial cleaning company based in Boca Raton, Florida; where he cleaned offices at night. He was an entrepreneur who was often quoted as saying "I am My Own Boss!" He found his moments of respite in fishing and watching old Western Movies.
