I loved hearing you laugh whenever I did something strange/silly, I loved the way you made the best food at the potlucks, and I loved how you were so funny too.

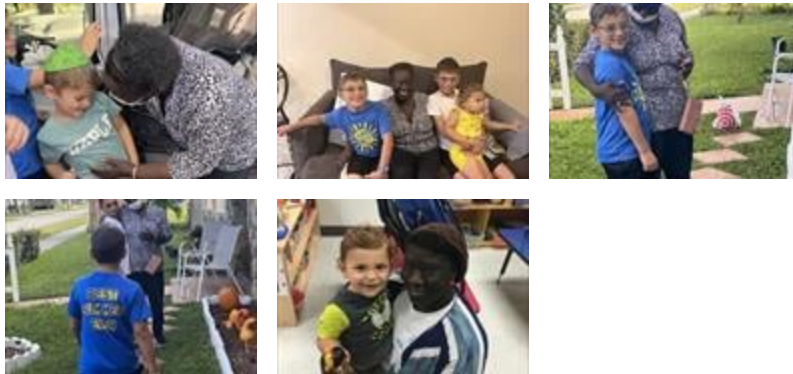
I have so many memories that I will cherish with you forever, I’m so grateful that we got the chance to cross paths.

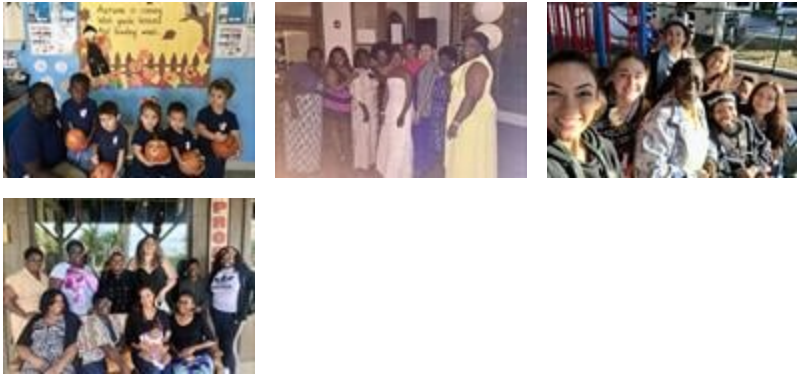

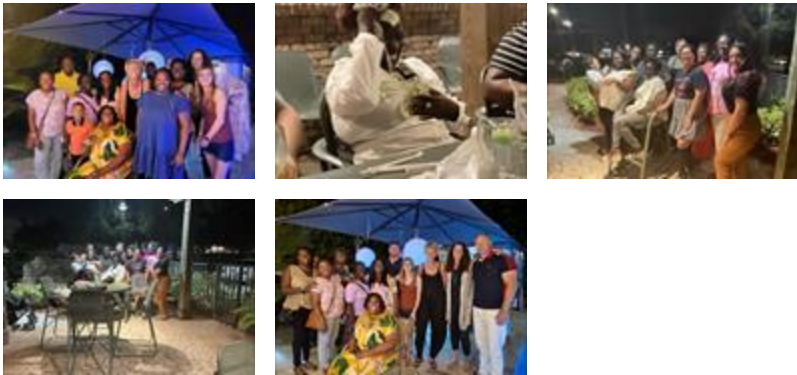
