Laconia Martin, a devoted mother and grandmother, supportive sister, aunt and friend was born to Mary Jackson and Calvin Johnson on December 8, 1958. “Con,” as she was affectionately known, was strong-willed yet gentle in nature. Her smile, welcoming and heart-warming. A dependable confidant, Con, was known to tell you what you needed to hear and genuinely wanting the best for others. She enjoyed spending countless hours on the phone with her sisters, shopping, and fellowshiping over a good meal. She always credited “mama” for the strength and wisdom she shared with her close-knit family and circle of friends.

Laconia was a lifelong resident of Pompano Beach. The faith that she embraced was developed and nurtured through her membership at Antioch Missionary Baptist Church. Laconia attended Coleman Elementary School, Pompano Beach Middle School and graduated from Pompano Beach High School in 1976. She was a proud Stillman Tiger, graduating from Stillman College in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. It was here that her life of service was enhanced when she joined Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. As a member with greater than 25 years of service, she earned the

Silver Star designation.

Upon entering the workforce, Laconia began her career in the banking industry. Her knowledge of banking and finance became a valuable resource for family and friends. After many years in banking, she ventured into education, working for almost 15 years for the School Board of Broward County. She retired from Cross Creek School in April 2025.

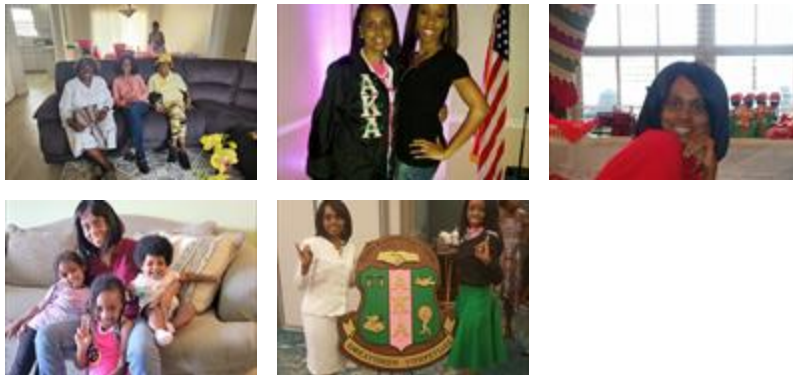

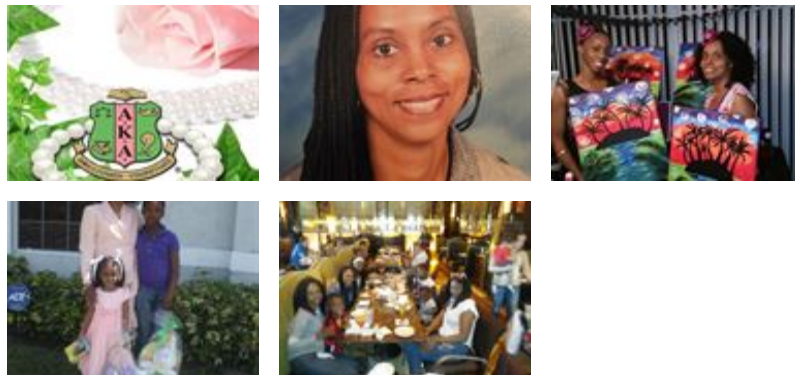

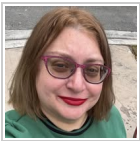
