Lamar Miles was born on December 18th, 1949 to the late Odessa Abraham and Samuel Green. He was raised by his mother and step-father PG Abraham.

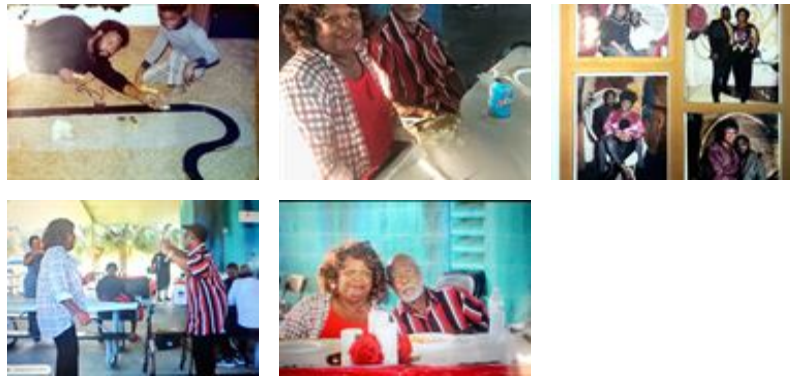

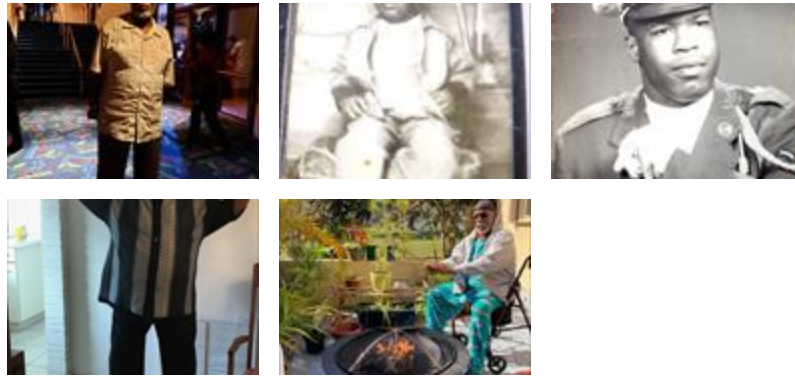
