Letaine Jean, also known as Lestenio or Manes, was born to the late Saintilia and Aristene Jean on August 27, 1943, in Jacmel, Haiti. He was the fourth of their seven children. After leaving Jacmel for Port-au-Prince, he became a baker, and later married the love of his life, Gracilia Berton, on July 14, 1973. In 1984, he migrated from Haiti to the United States, bringing his entire family over the next two decades. In the US, he worked as a landscaper, displaying a wonderful knack for solving problems. Letaine's life was defined by serving people in his community, especially his church members.

On Saturday, May 18, 2024, at the age of 80, Letaine passed away peacefully at his home. He was predeceased by two of his brothers, Liset and Benice, his two sisters Vilia Dejean and Marie-Leonne Lindor, and his son Vladimir Jean. Letaine is survived by his lovely wife of 50 years, Gracilia Jean, two of his brothers: Castel and Canes, and ten out of his eleven children: Naomie Felix, Mackendy Pierrette, Myrlene Fleuristin, Rodney Jean, Ruthlande Jean, James Jean, Kethia Sainvil, Junior Jean, Nathalie Payne, and Jonas Jean.
