



## Peter Mack Lovett

February 9, 1934 - December 2, 2023

Peter Mack Lovett was born February 9, 1934, to the parentage of the late Charlie Lovett, Sr. and the late Cassie Mathis Lovett in Pompano Beach, FL. Peter matriculated through Broward County Public Schools, graduating from Blanche Ely High School with inaugural class of 1951.

As an adolescent, Peter was raised in the fear of the Lord. He and his family were faithful members of Bethel AME Church in Pompano, Beach, FL.

After graduating from high school, he attended and graduated from Edward Waters University, formerly Edward Waters College in Jacksonville, FL. As an avid learner, he also attended Miami Barber College, becoming a licensed barber.

Upon completing his studies, Peter enlisted in the United States Air Force in May of 1954. He bravely served his country until honorably discharged in May 1962.

He returned to Pompano Beach and gained employment with the United States Postal Service.

Peter later relocated to Atlanta, Georgia where he worked diligently as supervisor of custodial services with Georgia Tech University.

In 2018, he returned home to Pompano Beach, FL to be closer to his children and grandchildren. Upon returning, he faithfully served with the men's department and as an elder at Temple of God, COGIC under the leadership of his son, Superintendent Rodney L. Lovett, Sr.

On December 2, 2023, Elder Peter Mack Lovett entered into his eternal rest.

He is preceded in death by his brothers, Charlie Lovett, Jr., Robert Lovett, and Dr. Leonard Lovett; his sisters, Pearlie Mae Hawkins, Margie Mcfadden, Bula Perry, and Bessie Jackson; and his eldest son Jeffery Lovett, Sr.
