Life's Reflection

Rosetta Hankins, 79, was called home to glory on May 17, 2022, in Pompano Beach, FL. Rosetta Hankins was 1 of 8 children born to the late Sidney Hankins and Julia Cooney Hankins in Pompano Beach, FL on September 5, 1942, with 6 siblings preceding her in death. At an early age Rosetta joined Bethel A.M.E. Church, then later in her adult life, she joined Antioch Missionary Baptist Church. Rosetta had two children whom she supported and loved very much, Janet Hankins and Robert Dupree. She received her education within the Broward County School System and attended Blanche Ely High School (Class of 1960). Understanding the importance of education, she would often say "man can take anything from you, but a good education he cannot". Therefore, as a mother and grandmother, Rosetta dedicated her life to ensuring that her children and grandchildren had the foundation of what they needed to be successful. Rosetta worked in the domestic care field. She would wake up early, put on her white uniform and work around the clock to ensure that she, her children, and grandchildren had the resources they needed for a good life.

Rosetta loved three things in life: she loved God, she loved her family, and she loved to work. One of her favorite pastimes was sitting on the front porch of her neighbor and good friend Georgia Mae Wright. Early in the mornings, they would watch children head to school, people move about the neighborhood and families prepare to go to work. Then after a cup of coffee

and their morning chat, Rosetta would head to work and Georgia Mae, who was retired, would proceed with her day.

Rosetta Hankins was preceded in death by her daughter Janet Hankins. She leaves to cherish her spirit and love: her son Robert Dupree, her brother Lucious Hankins, grandchildren Jennifer Jackson (Exavier), Talvin Vereen (Antoinette), Robert Rashad Dupree, Calesia Brenna Dupree, one great grandchild, Summer Hazel Vereen, a goddaughter, Chineqwa "NeNe" Small, and a number of nieces, nephews, other family members, and friends.
