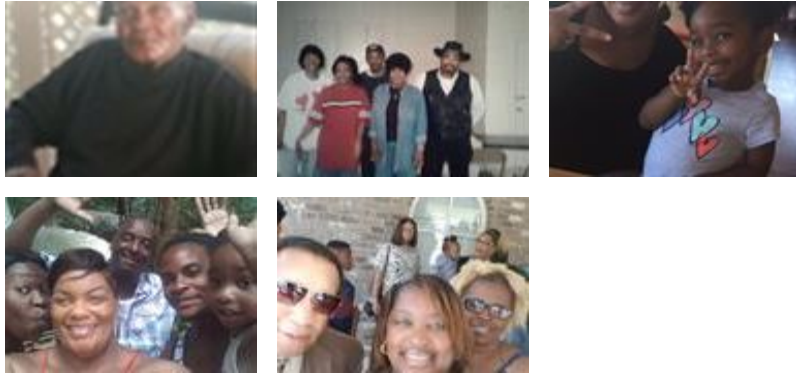


“ Dear Daddy,

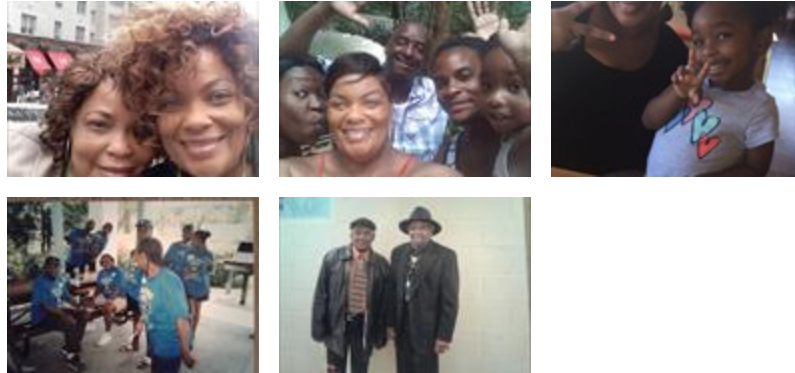
