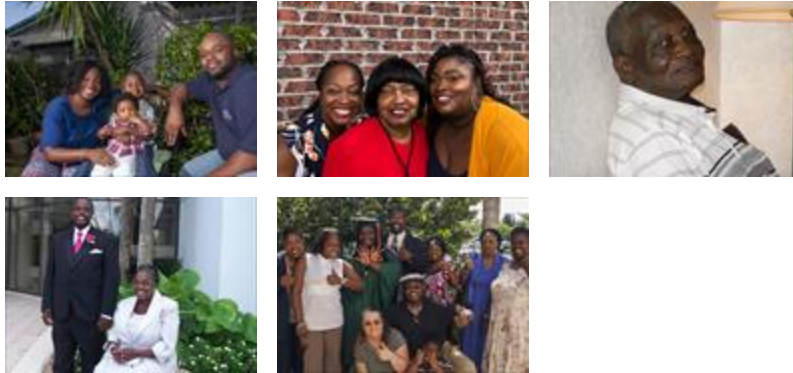

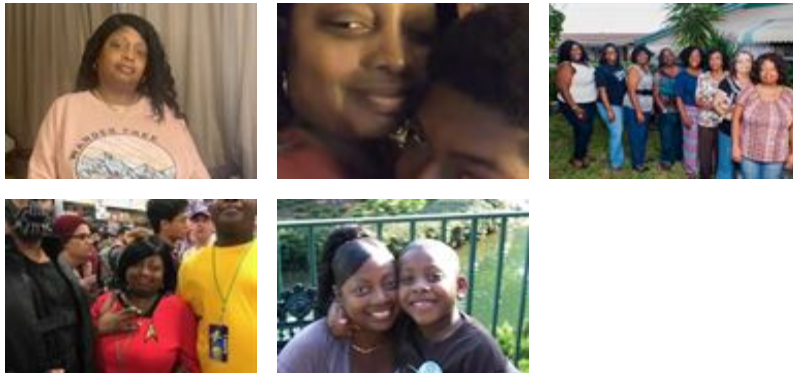

She loved going to Disney World,

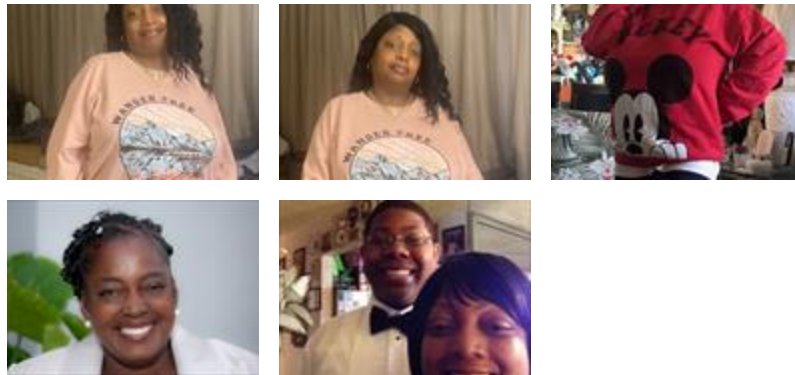
*She is now at rest and the first eyes she will see are eyes our family
