Vincent McKeever was born on October 18, 1964 in Neptune Township, New Jersey to the parentage of the late Wilson (Daddy Boy) McKeever and Mattie Jordan McKeever. Also preceding him in death was his sister Cathy E. McKeever-Williams.

Vincent was raised in Deerfield Beach, FL where he received his early education. For his secondary and post-secondary education, in the city of Henderson, Kentucky he graduated from Job Corps and attended Henderson Community College where he obtained his Certification as a Welder. He had a love for Welding work and riding his Motorcycle as a hobby.

He worked at All Service of Fort Lauderdale, FL now called Waste Management, and later employed by the City of Deerfield Beach as a Waste Container Worker for over 22 years, until his health unexpectedly began to fail him.
