Walter L. Chattman Sr. was born on May 9, 1948, in Boca Raton, Florida, to the late Christine Chatman McCall and Gene Cone. He later settled in Pompano Beach, where he met the love of his life, Alice Smith. The two were united in holy matrimony on June 27, 1971, and together they built a beautiful life, blessed with six children and sharing 54 years of marriage.

Walter proudly served his country in the United States Air Force as an Aircraft mechanic, including serving during the Vietnam War. After completing his military service, he returned to Pompano Beach, where he made his home for many years. In 2021, he and Alice relocated to Deerfield Beach, continuing their journey together.

In 2010, Walter was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease, a challenge he faced with remarkable courage, grace, and resilience. He passed away peacefully on October 13, 2025, surrounded by love.

Walter will be remembered as a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. His quiet strength, generous heart, and unwavering love for

his family touched everyone who knew him and left a lasting legacy. He was an avid football fan, especially of his beloved Dallas Cowboys, and his passion for the game brought joy to many Sundays.

He is survived by his beloved wife, Alice Chattman of Deerfield Beach, Florida, and their six children: Walicia Chattman of Crestview, Florida; Shameka Daniels (Morisse Sr.) of Crestview, Florida; Elaina Chattman of Saint Augustine, Florida; Tiffany Chattman of Pompano Beach, Florida; Sarah Chattman of Port Saint Lucie, Florida; and Walter Chattman Jr. of Palm Beach, Florida.

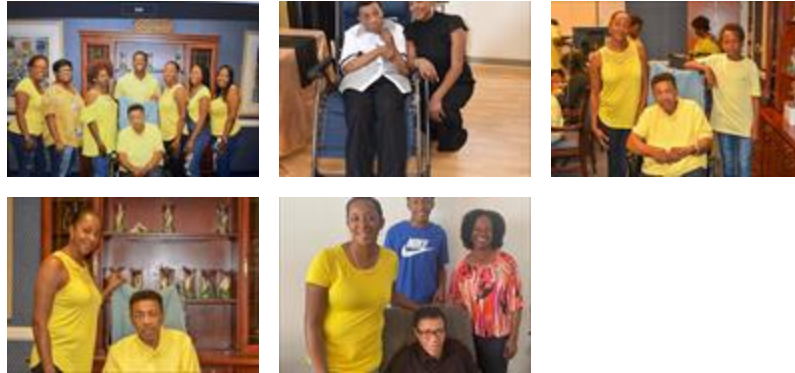

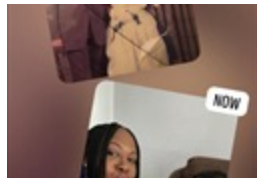
